

FINAL TRANSCRIPTS

To all Grade 12 Students and Parents of Grade 12's.

Final transcripts for grade 12 students are released by the Ministry of Education around July 31st. In the past, transcripts were mailed directly to the student. This year, for the first time, transcripts will NOT be mailed. Instead, students can access their transcripts directly from their BCeID account. All students were shown how to create this account in Graduation Transitions or in CAS.

As of May 31st, there are still 48 grade 12 students who have not created this account. Important Information regarding transcripts:

1. Students can access the StudentTranscripts Service at: www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca/. See photo below.
2. July 12th - Students need only complete their Post Secondary Institution (PSI) selections once in the current school year. Students may add to their selections at any time up to July 12, 2019. Students may make up to 25 selections free of charge within six months after completing their last course. After six months, students will be charged \$10 per transcript, payable on the StudentTranscripts Service. To select their PSIs, students must login to the StudentTranscripts Dashboard and under *Transcripts & Certificates*, select *Send/Order Your Transcript*. Students locate their desired PSIs from the list and select (dependent on the PSI's current process) the *option to "Send interim and final marks when they are available" or "Send final marks when they are available."*

3. **July 31st – Students can access their final transcript online.** (Note: If students look at their transcripts prior to this date, they will only see the courses that have been completed prior to June, 2019 so it will look as if their transcript is incomplete.)
4. Oct. 1, 2019 - Grade 12's taking summer school in 2019 will have their transcripts updated by this date. Again, students will have to login to their BCeID account to access their updated transcript.
